IMPORTANT LIVING HOPE UPDATE

The School and Property subcommittees met and unanimously approved that beginning next school year Living Hope Lutheran Childcare and School will be on the Woodlawn campus. There is room for each grade to have a large classroom. The childcare will be using the newer part of the building and will have two rooms and larger rooms for each age. All involved (committee members, teachers, and our new principal) strongly agreed that having the school at one location would be a blessing to this portion of our ministry.

There are a number of issues that will need to be addressed in order for this plan to work. We have already begun to work with designers and others who can help us upgrade the facility and prepare rooms to be classrooms.

With the school in one location, we are hoping to use the Good Shepherd's gym as a sanctuary for unified worship. But do not think of this as worshiping in a gym! We want to convert the large rectangular building (now called a gym) into a worship space using the current building as an exterior shell to house our new worship space. Other parts of the current school building might be converted to offices, Bible Class rooms, a narthex, or fellowship space. These plans are tentative, but we have walked through the building with designers who have experience with these types of renovations.

This appears to be a wonderful opportunity to expand and unite our ministry! While it will not be inexpensive, it will cost much less than acquiring land and/or building new buildings. We will face challenges so please pray for God's blessings.
