






First Lesson

1 Kings 22:17-23

¹⁷Then Micaiah said, "I saw all Israel scattered on the mountains like sheep that have no shepherd, and the LORD said, 'They have no masters. Each one should return to his home in peace."

¹⁸Then the king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat, "Didn't I tell you that he does not prophesy anything good about me, but only bad?"

¹⁹Then Micaiah said:

Now hear this word from the LORD.

I saw the LORD sitting on his throne, and the whole army of heaven was standing around him, on his right and on his left.

²⁰Then the LORD said, "Who will entice Ahab so that he goes up and falls at Ramoth Gilead?"


One spirit said this. Another one said that. ²¹Finally a spirit came and stood before the LORD and said, "I will entice him."

The LORD said to him, "How?"

²²He said, "I will go and be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets."

Then the LORD said, "You will entice him successfully. Go and do it."

²³Now look! The LORD has put a lying spirit into the mouths of all these prophets of yours, for the LORD has decreed disaster for you.

Second Lesson

2 Peter 1:20-2:3

²⁰Since we know this above all else: No prophecy of Scripture comes about from someone's own interpretation. ²¹In fact, no prophecy ever came by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were being carried along by the Holy Spirit.

¹There were false prophets also among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you. They will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them, bringing swift destruction on themselves. ²Many will follow their depraved ways, and because of them the way of the truth will be blasphemed. ³In their greed they will exploit you with fabricated messages. Their condemnation announced long ago is not idle, and their destruction is not asleep.

Verse of the Day

Alleluia. Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path. Alleluia. (Psalm 119:105) C: (sings) Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia.



¹⁵"Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. ¹⁶By their fruit you will recognize them. You do not gather grapes from thorn bushes or figs from thistles, do you? ¹⁷So then, every good tree produces good fruit, but a bad tree produces bad fruit. ¹⁸A good tree cannot produce bad fruit, and a bad tree cannot produce good fruit. ¹⁹Every tree that does not produce good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. ²⁰So then, by their fruit you will recognize them. ²¹Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven. ²²Many will say to me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name and drive out demons in your name and perform many miracles in your name?' ²³Then I will tell them plainly, 'I never knew you. Depart from me, you evildoers.'

²⁴"Everyone who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on bedrock. ²⁵The rain came down, the rivers rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house. But it did not fall, because it was founded on bedrock. ²⁶Everyone who hears these words of mine but does not do them will be like a foolish man who built his house on sand. ²⁷The rain came down, the rivers rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell—it was completely destroyed."

²⁸When Jesus finished speaking these words, the crowds were amazed at his teaching, ²⁹because he taught them as one who had authority, and not like their experts in the law.



NICENE CREED

WE BELIEVE in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.





Prayers & Lord's Prayer




WORDS OF INSTITUTION



The peace of the Lord be with you always.





Distribution

<u>For our Visitors:</u> "May I receive the Lord's Supper here today?" The Lord's Supper is a priceless medicine for the soul. We do everything we can to encourage its proper use. We also recognize from God's Word (1 Corinthians 11:23-32) that this medicine is a prescription item. Used for the wrong reasons by someone who does not understand it correctly, the Lord's Supper can actually cause spiritual harm. For that reason we, like the corner druggist, do not dispense it over-the-counter. Out of concern for each individual's spiritual welfare, we try to ensure that communion will be properly used by all in accord with our Lord's own will. We ask that if you have not received this sacrament here before, to please refrain from communing until you have had an opportunity to talk with one of our pastors. We also offer a light color non-alcoholic wine in the center of the tray for those who cannot have alcohol because of medical conditions.
