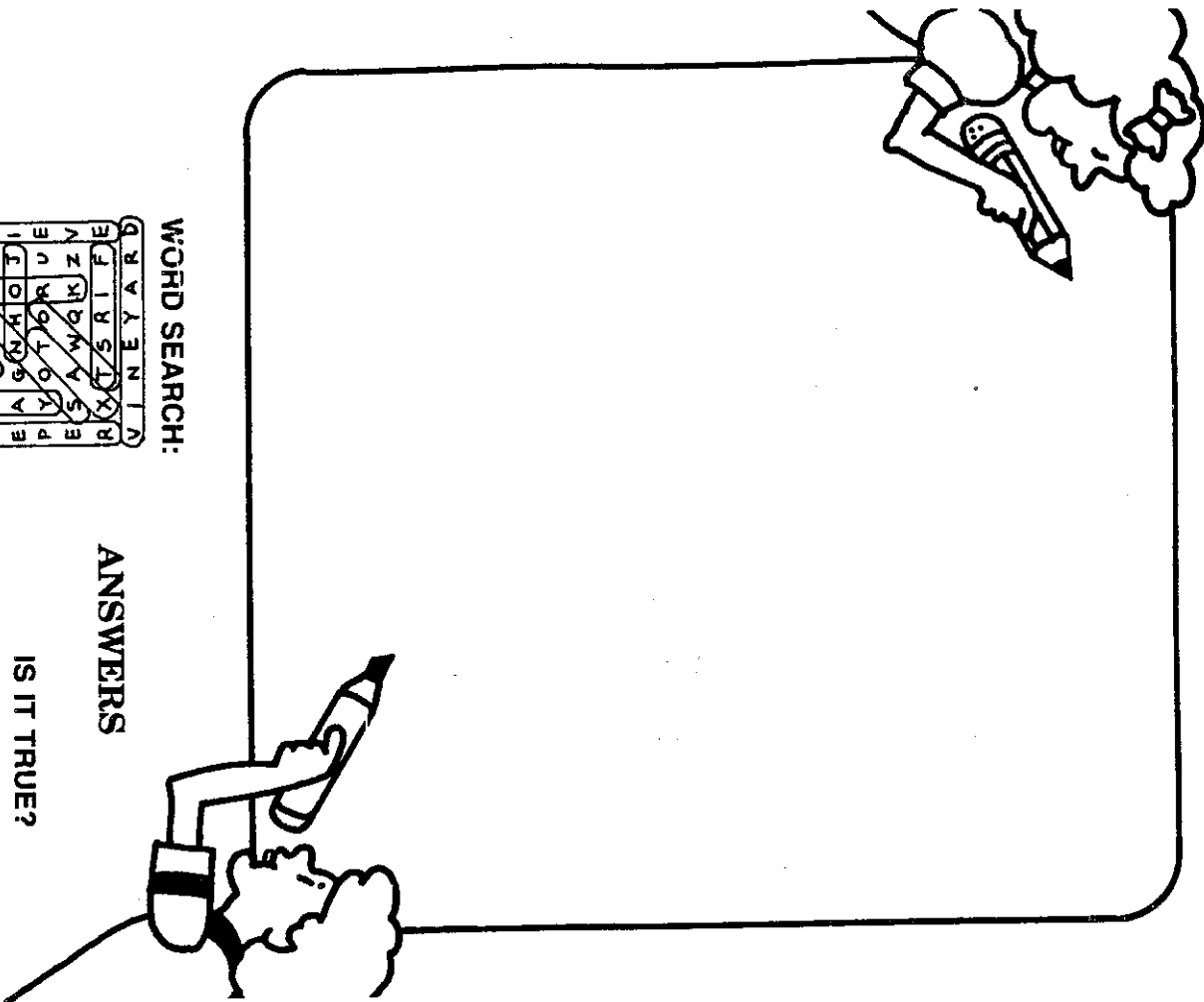

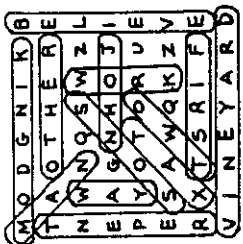

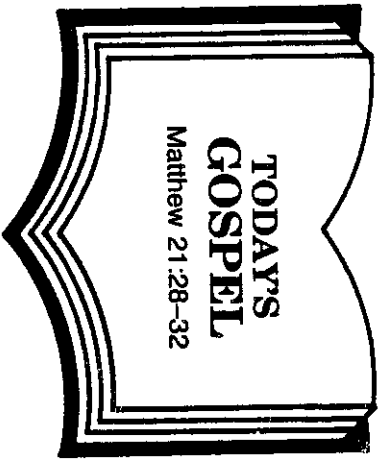

Sentence 5 is not true.

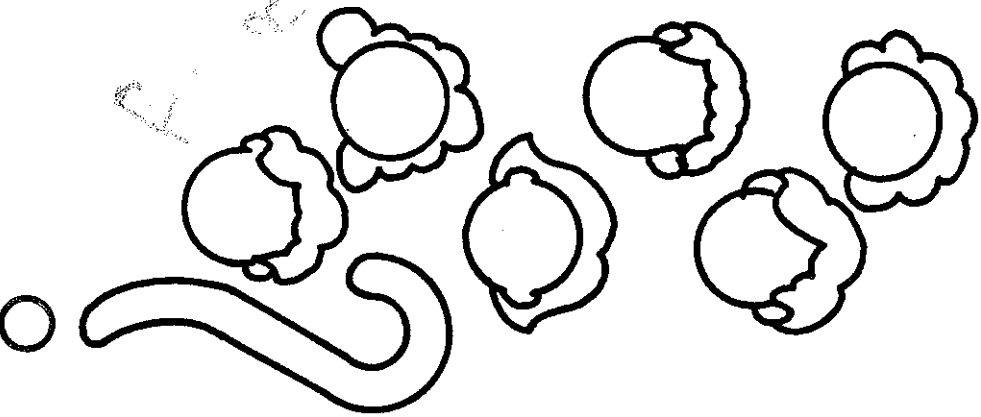
