NEW BIBLE CLASS! When we say "there are elephants in the room," we mean that people are ignoring important issues. Theistic evolution relies on ignoring key biblical teachings in order to appear reasonable. Our next Bible Class topic is called, "*Elephants in the Room: Evolution Versus the Message of Scripture.*"

Using God's Word alone, former Woodlawn member and NPH editor Pastor Robert Koester breaks down evolutionary arguments and shows believers how to discern biblical teachings about creation from common doctrinal errors. In this seven-lesson Bible study participants will gain a better ability to discuss these problems with others and avoid confusion about science's relationship with God's Word. They will also learn about incompatibilities between Scripture and evolution as well as the doctrinal errors that arise when they are combined.
