VOTERS MEETING

This past Wednesday we conducted our spring Voters Meeting. We met at Jordan Lutheran Church so both congregations could read and discuss the budget for our Lamb of God School. Final calculations will be made in the fall after school resumes, but the overall budget is approximately \$521,000. Woodlawn's support will be approx. \$221,000. After that presentation, each congregation met separately and approved the school budget.

Our voters then held the regular meeting. The pastors' report is available in the carousel near the main church entrance. Having passed the school budget, the Voters then approved the Woodlawn budget of approx. \$496,000 dollars. We increased our commitment to WELS Missions to \$30,000 and to WLHS to \$24,000. Copies of the budget are also in the carousel. Brief updates were given on the merger discussions (meetings resuming in the next 2 weeks) and the sanctuary audio/video project, scheduled to begin in the coming weeks). Finally, a slate of nominees was presented and passed unanimously. Four men have agreed to serve – John Klein Sr., Jef Jaeger, Shawn Woller and David Schoephoester. We still have FOUR vacancies on the council. If any of our men would like to be considered for one of the openings, please speak to one of the pastors or to chairman, Dr. Joel Davis.
